CONCRETO is a 36-month project bringing together 13 partners from 4 EU countries and 1 extra-EU to promote the **GREEN REHABILITATION** of **EUROPEAN CONCRETE ARCHITECTURE**. Inspired by the Renaissance idea of the "Artist's Shop" or "La Bottega", the CONCRETO ALLIANCE works together on a learner-centred, INNOVATIVE apprenticeship programme, where students and professionals acquire and practice skills on real-life examples, progressing from students to APPRENTICES. The CONCRETO Partners **recognise the LACK** of specialist skills available and the **NEED TO DEVELOP GUIDELINES AND STANDARDS** for the quality regeneration and maintenance of our MODERN CONCRETE BUILDINGS. From here, the INNOVATIVE IDEA of creating a cross-sectoral knowledge flow, promoting best practices by fostering a **NEW SKILL SET** to better equip professionals to become the experts of **TOMORROW**.

CONCRETO Academy will:

- Gives life to the **CONCRETO ALLIANCE** to promote transnational cooperation and mutual learning between academia, vocational training and professionals in the field, bridging the two-way approach, the principle (academia) and the practice (field) through all CONCRETO activities.
- Brings together 84 students and more than 30 teachers to participate in the 3-year programme with activities in 2 EU countries (Italy, Spain) and Türkiye and 1 UNESCO site in Ivrea (Italy), where the students will actively carry out maintenance and regeneration work on selected buildings as their final project (CONCRETO MASTERPIECE), contributing to their green sustainability.
- Produced the CONCRETO ALLIANCE CODE BOOK, a baseline that
 identifies the skills required to renovate quality architecture, and
 ultimately will publish the CONCRETO GUIDELINES the CORE of
 CONCRETO sustainability, and a MOOC with the project results available
 on the open platform of the CONCRETO ACADEMY, a permanent
 opportunity for knowledge growth and exchange, promoting "smarter"
 and "greener" renovations.

CONCRETO envisions synchronous as well as asynchronous interaction with the participants, which will include a group comprised of students of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs), and learners from Vocational Education Training (VET) organizations, together with professionals selected by the National Trade Associations of the respective countries for a total of 28 participants each year.

CONCRETO is defined as learner-centred, engaging and based on real life experience becoming today's and tomorrow's "artist shop for concrete architecture and its rehabilitation methods" (La bottega delle riparazioni del cemento). CONCRETO is conceived as a EUROPEAN INCUBATOR to promote and foster best practices for the Rehabilitation of our Concrete Quality Building Stock.

TEACHING & TRAINING ACTIVITIES:

The CONCRETO Consortium recognizes the need to update "traditional" sectoral skills and to make them more relevant to the new integrated approach in line with EU priorities.

To do this, CONCRETO identified FIVE SKILL PILLARS of theoretical and practical knowledge for PROFESSIONALS to master, when engaged with the REHABILIATION and REGENERATION of our CONCRETE buildings:

- Concrete Assessment / Investigation
- Concrete Repair Traditional Repair and Electrochemical Repair
- Surface Treatment
- Concrete Retrofitting and Improvement of Energy Performance
- Monitoring/Maintenance/Site Management

The FIVE SKILL PILLARS are integrated in the CONCRETO intellectual journey through DIFFERENT LEARNING PROCESSES and METHODOLOGIES: Distance Learning (CONCRETO STEPPINGSTONE); In-class lectures & Hands-on Practice (CONCRETO MASTER YOUR SKILLS); and Field work at the Unesco Site of Ivrea (CONCRETO MASTERPIECE).
