
The creative quarter on Dachauer Strasse is an up-and-coming and lively district in Munich.


The aim was to create a place for academic and industrial innovation that combines architecture, design and technology.

The feeling of openness is created by column-free spaces. Together with the compact, private levels, in which the professors work areas and the rooms for teaching and research are located, the overall composition of the building is created. The fa ade elements incorporate the residential levels through horizontal elements and make them visible from the outside. The glazing behind them provides transparency and additional lighting.








## Analysis of an urban environment


